



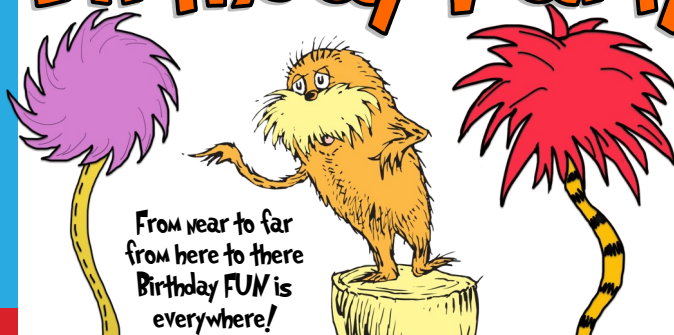

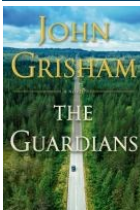

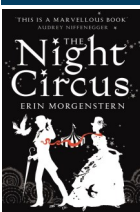

This book is John Grisham's 40th book and all about fighting wrongful convictions throughout southern US. He is one of my favourite authors and this book did not disappoint.

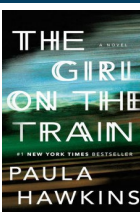
