EGG CARTON FLOWER AND BUTTERFLY

You'll Need:

- An egg carton (without the eggs!)
- Paint or markers
- A straw
- Pipe cleaner

Instructions:

1. Cut the egg carton into groups of four, so it forms a square. If you have a carton for a dozen eggs, you can make three of these groups.
2. Trim the edges of the square so it makes a rounder shape for the petals/wings.
3. Paint or colour the egg carton, then wait for the it to dry
4. To make the butterfly, take one pipe cleaner and wrap it around the middle of the square. Twist the pipe cleaner off at the top and bend the ends into an antenna shape.
5. To make the flower, turn the square over and tape a straw to the back to make the stem. Use a pipe cleaner to twist into leaves. Alternatively, you can make paper leaves and tape them onto the straw stem.
